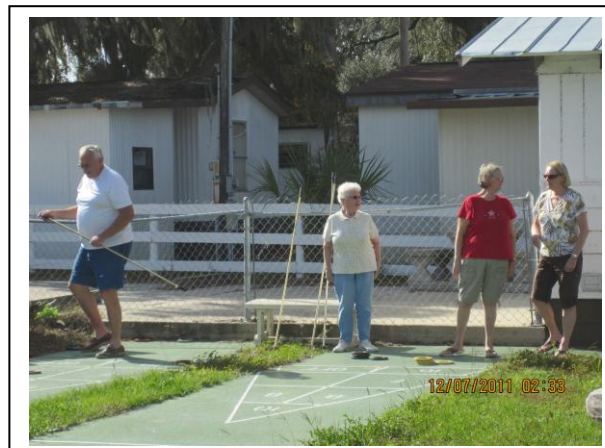
PET OF THE MONTH

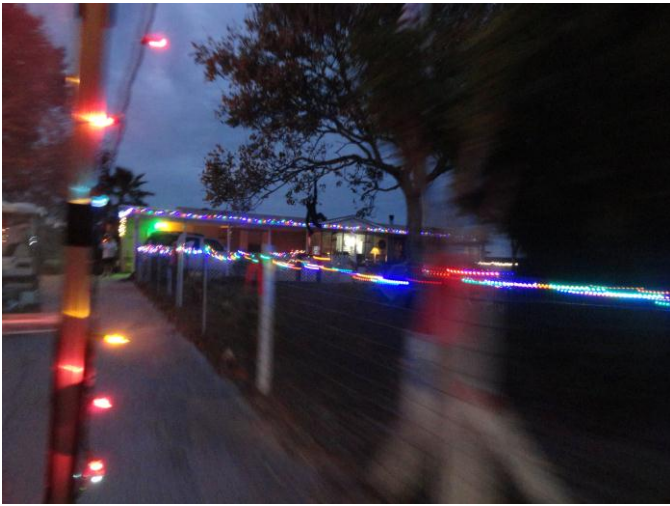

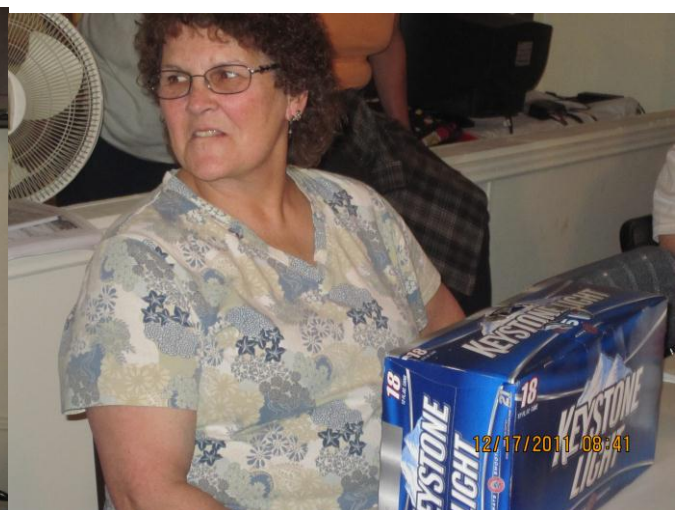
